ORDER TERMINATING RESPONDENT’S PROBATION

On September 26, 2019, Courtney Carroll, agent no. G-000012, (“Respondent”) an employee of ForwardGro, LLC, (“ForwardGro”) entered into a Consent Order with the Maryland Medical Cannabis Commission (“Commission”) that included the following orders:

ORDERED that following the period of stayed suspension, Ms. Carroll’s grower registration shall be placed on **PROBATION** for a period of **TWELVE MONTHS**, ...

...; and it is further

ORDERED that beginning six-months into her probation period or at the termination of ForwardGro’s probation under ForwardGro’s Consent Order with the Commission, whichever is sooner, Ms. Carroll may submit a written petition to the Commission requesting termination of probation. After consideration of the petition, the Commission or a group of Commissioners meeting as a committee or a Case Resolution Conference panel may terminate the Respondent’s probation through an order if the Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all of the terms and conditions of probation and this Consent Order; ...

Respondent began her period of stayed suspension on September 26, 2019 and began her probation period exactly twelve (12) months later. ForwardGro’s period of probation was terminated by Order of the Commission dated January 27, 2021 and the Respondent has fully and satisfactorily complied with all the terms and conditions of probation and Respondent’s Consent Order with the Commission.

Accordingly, the Commission **GRANTS** the Respondent's petition according to the following Order.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Decision, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Respondent's period of probation under the terms of the September 26, 2019 Consent Order is ended and that the Respondent has satisfied all terms and conditions as required;

ORDERED that the Respondent shall incur all costs associated with this Consent Order; and it is further

ORDERED that this Consent Order is a **PUBLIC DOCUMENT** pursuant to Md. Code Ann., Gen. Prov. § 4-401 *et seq.* (2014).
