### **Summary**

This proposal allows vegetable oil, including coconut oil, in capsule products containing cannabis, subject to certain processing requirements for edibles.

*(a) “Capsule” means a cannabis-infused product in a hard or soft soluble shell, with or without other ingredients, that is intended for oral consumption.*

*(b) For capsules containing vegetable oil, the capsule must be processed in accordance with the regulation of edible cannabis products under COMAR 10.62.37, except for COMAR 10.62.37.03 and COMAR 10.62.37.12B(1).*

#### **10.62.37 Edible Cannabis Products**

##### **.21 Medical Cannabis Products and Components Not Subject to This Chapter.**

A. Regulations .01—.19 of this chapter do not apply to the following:

(3) Medical cannabis-infused products [as defined in COMAR 10.62.23.01B(3)(c)] *that do not contain any food ingredients, except:*

*(a) Capsules containing vegetable oil, as defined in COMAR 10.62.01.01B(5)(b); or*

*(b) Tinctures containing vegetable oil, as defined in COMAR 10.62.23.01B(3)(c).*
