ORDER TERMINATING PROBATION

In August and September 2023, the Maryland Cannabis Administration (“MCA” or the “Administration”), pursuant to the Cannabis Reform Act (the “Act”), codified at Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis Article, § 36-501, *et seq.* (2023 Supp.) and Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 14.17 (2023) and COMAR 10.26 (2021) (to the extent it was applicable at the time of the violations), identified several violations of the Act and COMAR related to unauthorized transfers of ownership in **PHARMACANN, INC.**’s (“Respondent’s”) licensees.

On December 13, 2023, the MCA and Respondent entered into a Consent Order to resolve these violations without the need for an evidentiary hearing. The Consent Order required Respondent to meet certain terms and conditions, including payment of a fine in the amount of \$30,000, within a two-year probationary period. Having verified that Respondent has successfully satisfied those terms and conditions as agreed upon in the Consent Order, it is hereby


ORDERED that Respondent’s **PROBATION IS TERMINATED**; and it is further
