



Drug Enforcement Administration Inspections at Cannabis Dispensaries

(June 26, 2026) - Recently, the Maryland Cannabis Administration (MCA) learned of several unannounced Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) inspections occurring at cannabis businesses. We believe the on-site inspections were in response to the business' application for DEA registration. At this time, MCA is not aware of any DEA inspections occurring in Maryland.

As a reminder, Maryland law remains fully operative and unchanged, and state licensing and enforcement continues as enacted by Maryland General Assembly. Businesses that choose not to register with the DEA will not face any action by the MCA.
